"Good-Justly-Mercy-Humbly"

There is a statement inspired of God by Micah concerning God's law found in Micah 6:8

"He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you but to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?"

Charles W. Eliot, then president of Harvard University said, "Nothing in the history of literature is more worthy than these words of the prophet Micah." They stand as true in the twenty first century as when they were first written in the eighth century B.C. Could we say these words are the high watermark of the book of Micah?

Micah preached against the sins and injustices of his time in an effort to turn the hearts of his people back to God.

The words of God by Micah are pure statements of the Old Testament which in simple terms sums up the heart of our walk with the Lord.

The order of things for the child of God instructs us the way the saved are to walk. When we practice it daily, we will please both God and our fellow man.

It is not easy sometimes to show the character that God requires. There must be no change in our thinking or actions in different locations or situations, whether in the church meeting house or the marketplace. (Read Amos 5:21-24). A genuine New Testament Christian and social injustice never walk together.

The message we find in Micah's day when judges were bought with bribes; when merchants used two sets of weights; one to buy and another to sell, the honorable religion was just an imitation for show.

I believe you would agree that the message of Micah is needed in our day. With each generation the same old problems came along to be dealt with.

The character of mankind runs in the same vain to bring on heartache and care. It gives those who fight against the adversary needed resources to proclaim the doctrine of Christ.

God continually shows us what is good. The basics of good have three elements. There is acting justly, loving mercy and walking humbly by remaining responsive to God – submitting to His will.
