Mark 10:32-52

### Discover the Bible

1. Jesus was traveling toward Jerusalem. Color the place Jesus was traveling to. Jesus told the twelve apostles that he was going to be killed, but three days later he would rise from the grave! With blue, trace the number of days Jesus would be in the grave.

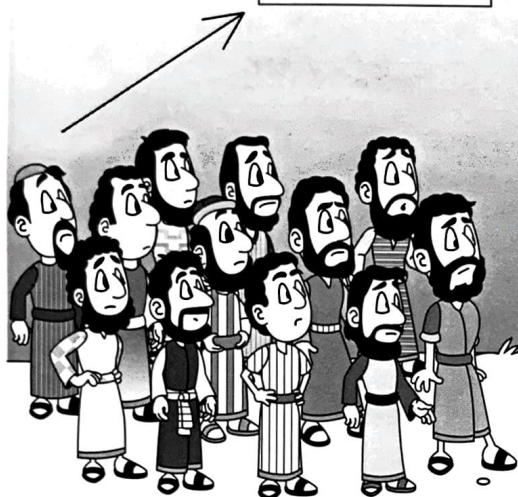
2. James and John asked Jesus, "Can we sit beside you when you are king and be your most important men?" Draw lines from James and John to the places where they wanted to sit. Jesus said, "God will decide who will sit in these special places." Color the "God" cloud.

3. Jesus called the twelve apostles together. Count the twelve apostles. Say the "Apostles" chant. Jesus told the apostles, "Don't be like the people who want to be the most important. Instead, be a servant. To become great, you must serve others." Color the serving hand. Jesus came to earth to be a servant and to die for our sins! Trace the cross. Jesus served people and he wants us to serve people too! How can you serve people like Jesus did?

4. A blind man named Bartimaeus shouted to Jesus, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" Who was David? (a king) Jesus was in the family of David. Color the man who shouted to Jesus. Bartimaeus told Jesus that he wanted to see. Jesus said, "Your faith has healed you!" Bartimaeus could see!

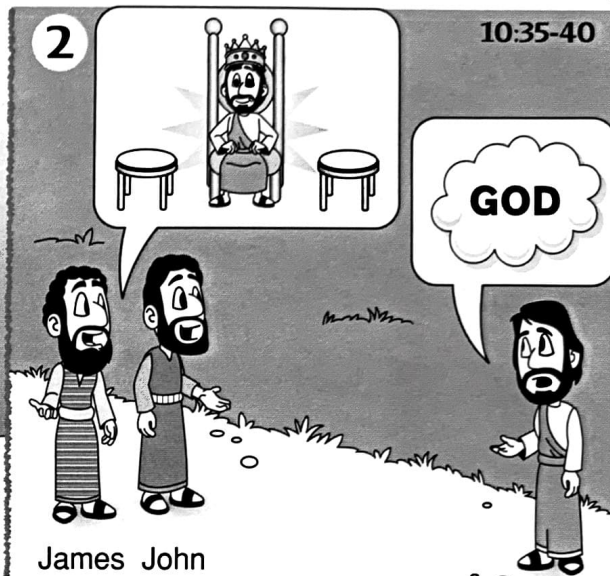

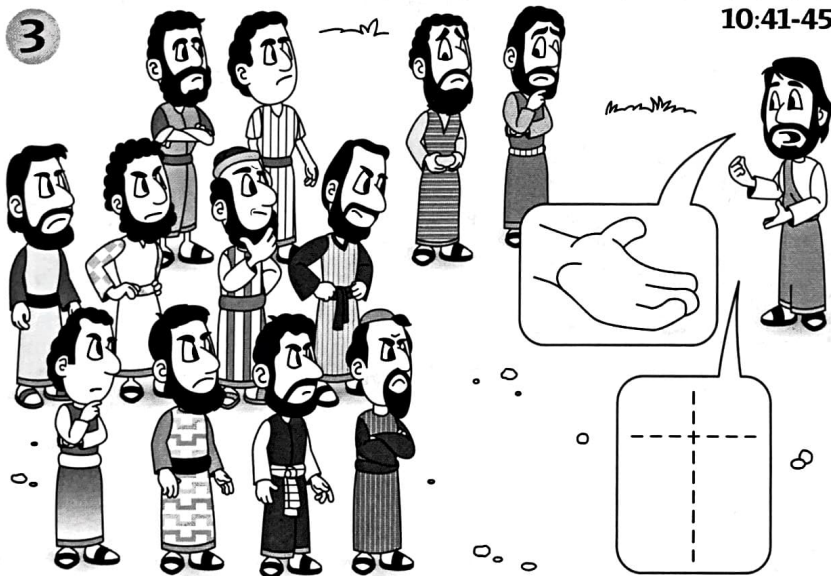

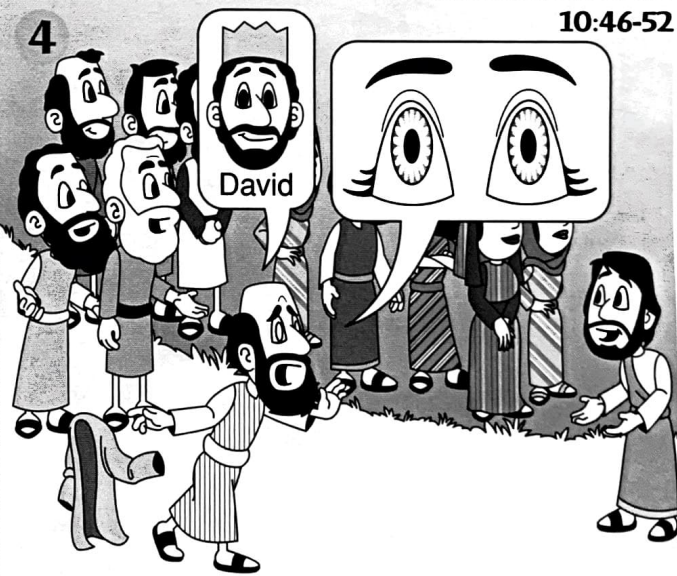
