“WONDERFUL INSTRUCTION”

Two of the most beloved verses in the Bible can be found in Proverbs 3:5 – 6 “Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.” Many people have quoted, memorized, and used these words throughout life. This passage is strikingly simplistic, and the youngest believer can understand it, and it also comforts the oldest saint of God. Learning this passage will be a tremendous benefit now and throughout your life. This verse is a microcosm of what it means to walk with God. There are four keywords worthy of our attention that unlock the message of this text.

“Trust in the Lord with all thine heart...” In Hebrew, “trust” means “to lean with the full body.” This carries with it the idea of lying on your bed at night with your total weight supported by the mattress and frame so that you can rest. Our rendering of the word trust means to have confidence in something, but the Hebrew word has a much deeper meaning. We are safe and secure in the Lord and can depend on Him completely to support us securely. ...continued inside

“**Lean not...**” Recently with my hip replacement surgery, I used a walker to support me as I built my strength. Leaning on it supplied steadiness and security. The next step was to progress to a cane for support when needed. The word in our text, “lean,” means to lean against a tree or a mountain that cannot be moved or shaken. God’s word provides all the strength and support for every situation we will face in life.

“**Unto thine own understanding...**” “Understanding” means using your mental processes to analyze your problems, breaking them into smaller parts to make a decision. Here’s the idea, use the abilities that God has given you, but don’t lean upon that alone; trust in the Lord and wholly rest your weight on Him.

“**In all your ways acknowledge Him...**” If someone asks me if I know Michael Jordan or Larry Bird, I will respond yes! But do I really know them to be able to call them? There is another knowing, which is how I know my wife. I have been with her almost every day for well over thirty years. We can finish each other’s sentences because of our relationship because we are married to each other. In verse five we could translate this verse “In all your ways know God intimately, personally and profoundly.” Great things will happen when we have this kind of relationship with God.
